Subject: Urgent Notice of Investigation and Immediate Compliance Demand

Dear President,

This letter serves as an **urgent and formal notice** from the International Mixed Martial Arts Federation (IMMAF) Disciplinary Committee regarding a grave breach of IMMAF statutes by Ms. Madeleine Fagerlind, Vice President of the Swedish MMA Federation. The matter at hand not only threatens the integrity of our federation but also undermines the regulatory framework that governs our affiliated bodies.

Incident Description: We have received official complaints from three European MMA Federations reporting that Ms. Fagerlind is participating in the 2024 GAMMA European MMA Championship (U18) held from May 12 to 19 in Slovakia. This event, organized by a body not affiliated with IMMAF, falls directly in conflict with our governing statutes. Specifically, **Article 9, Section 8** of the IMMAF statutes explicitly prohibits members from participating in or attending events hosted by non-affiliated organizations. This prohibition is a fundamental statute designed to maintain the integrity and exclusivity of our sanctioned events and affiliations.

Breach of Statutes: The actions taken by Ms. Fagerlind represent a serious violation of IMMAF's regulations and exhibit a disregard for the ethical and operational standards we uphold. Such behaviour not only contravenes Article 9, Section 8 but potentially implicates broader ethical violations under our comprehensive regulatory framework.

Immediate Actions Required: Given the severity of this infraction, the Swedish MMA Federation is required to:

1. Provide a **detailed and immediate explanation** for the unauthorized participation of Ms. Fagerlind in the aforementioned event.
2. Submit any supporting documents or evidence that may contextualize or mitigate the breach.


3. Outline the steps your federation intends to take to rectify this breach and prevent future occurrences.

Compliance Deadline: We expect a full response, with all requested documents and action plans, within 7 working days from this notice. Failure to adequately address this notice will result in immediate disciplinary actions, which may include sanctions, suspension, or other measures as deemed appropriate under IMMAF statutes.

Conclusion: The Swedish MMA Federation's cooperation in this matter is not only expected but required under the terms of your affiliation with IMMAF. We take these issues very seriously and anticipate your prompt and complete cooperation to resolve this matter swiftly and decisively.

We await your immediate response and thank you in advance for your cooperation in upholding the standards and integrity of the sport of MMA.
